As a local business owner, I am writing to let you know that we are planning to have a partial road closure on Upper Borough Walls to host a series of Sunday Art Fares and two "Jazz In The Square" events.

The dates for these events would be Sundays only through August, September & October and also the August Bank Holiday Monday.

The application for the partial road closure will be in effect on these Sundays between the hours of 11am and 11pm. There will of course be provision made for emergency access for the Mineral Hospital and other essential vehicle movement along Upper Borough Walls. In addition, the traffic that there is on these Sundays will be diverted along Barton Street between these hours.

The plans as they stand would be to hold "Jazz In The Square" Sundays on August 15th and September 12th or 19th. On the remaining Sunday's there will be a series of Art Fares consisting of approximately 20 small stalls. The events would be contained within the parameters of the Sawclose car park and space immediately outside Gascoyne Place.

All of these events will be free to the general public and are aimed at profiling Sawclose as a public space and not just a car park.

I know that many of the businesses on Upper Borough Walls do close on Sundays and that those that trade do not have essential deliveries on Sundays so we hope that this will not disrupt your business in any way.
