Petition re double yellow lines on Durley hill ,Keynsham.

I am presenting this petition on behalf of the owner and customers of the Rest a While café at junction of Old Bristol road and Durley hill,Keynsham.

Double yellow lines were proposed at this location last summer and posted on usual type of location but officers did not specifically notify the business.

It is a long established traditional transport café having many regular customers, who stop for a short break. They have comfortably co existed with the local community.

However recent changes in behaviour at the nearby football club caused major problems at weekends for residents with irresponsible parking which led to the TRo and yellow lines. The business recognises this problem and therefore their request is minor – please could the order be amended to a single yellow line with say 1 hour limit on a short stretch up to the speed limit sign thus recognising the area previously used by his patrons over many years.
