The Issue	Whether to implement the issues which were raised during the public consultation that ended on 6 th February 2014.
Decision Date	7 th April 2014
The decision	 The Cabinet Member agrees that the proposal is introduced as advertised, but with the following exceptions:- To create 3 unrestricted parking bays on the east side of Weston Park East. To extend the proposed unrestricted parking bay near Weston Park Court for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.
Rationale for decision	In accordance with Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, the proposals are designed to 'facilitate the passage on the road of any class of traffic and pedestrians', and to 'avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or to prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising'.
Financial and budget implications	These TRO's form part of the Section 106 works being carried out by the developer of the Royal High Junior School. There are no additional cost implications as a result of this report.
