The Issue	The Cabinet member is asked to decide whether to object to the Developer's proposals to name two streets as 'Market Walk' in the Keynsham new build scheme.

The decision	The Cabinet Member decides not to object
Rationale for decision	The Developer found names put forward as part of the public consultation unacceptable and has therefore proposed a single name for the street created as part of the new development.
	In light of the concerns expressed about the Developers choice of name (see 5.3) it is necessary for a decision to be made on whether to object to the proposal.
