<b>The Issue</b>	Hinton Blewett Conservation Area Appraisal
<b>Decision Date</b>	23 July 2014
<b>The decision</b>	The Cabinet Member and Council Leader agree that the Hinton Blewett Conservation Area Appraisal should be formally adopted by the Council.
<b>Rationale for decision</b>	An assessment of the special interest and a description of the architectural qualities; identify opportunities for enhancement; recommend management proposals; review and propose for two boundary extensions; explanation of the planning policy context.
<b>Financial and budget implications</b>	There will be small costs incurred following the decision and adoption relating to minor administrative tasks.
<b>Issues considered</b>	Sustainability; Human Resources; Property; Other Legal Considerations
<b>Consultation undertaken</b>	Parish Council; Staff; Service Users; Local Residents
<b>How consultation was carried out</b>	Consultation was undertaken with Parish Council, local community, B&NES Planning Policy and a public meeting was held by the Council at the community hall in Hinton Blewett at the beginning of the formal 6-week consultation period. A copy of the draft Hinton Blewett Conservation Area Appraisal was made available on the Council's website and hard copies made available to Hinton Blewett Parish Council and residents and contributions were sought. The draft document was considered and commented on by the Combe Hay Parish Council taking advice from constituents as necessary and the Conservation Area Appraisal was amended accordingly.
