1 THE ISSUE

1.1 An application has been received for a variation to a Premises Licence under section.17 of the Licensing Act 2003 in respect of the Loch Fyne Restaurant, 24 Milsom Street, Bath, BA1 1DG.

2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 That the Sub Committee determines this application.

3 RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The costs of processing licences are covered by the fees charged. The fee for this application is £315.00

4 STATUTORY CONSIDERATIONS AND BASIS FOR PROPOSAL

- 4.1 An Equality Impact Assessment (Eq1A) has been completed. No adverse or other significant issues were found.
- 4.2 Consideration must be given to the Human Rights Act 1998 and the "convention rights".
- 4.3 The Sub Committee have been delegated authority to determine the application on behalf of the Licensing Authority in accordance with the Licensing Act 2003.
- 4.4 When reaching a decision, the Licensing Authority must carry out its functions with a view to promoting the four licensing objectives.

5 THE REPORT

- 5.1 An application has been received to vary the Premises Licence (Annex A).
- 5.2 The application proposes:
 - 1) The Sale of Alcohol for consumption both on and off the premises:

Monday to Saturday

08:00 - 00:00

Sunday

08:00 - 23:30

The current hours for the Sale of Alcohol are:

2) Opening Hours (remain unchanged)

The application also seeks to remove the following condition from the current licence:

- 5.3 The Licensing Act 2003 (Section 4) states that it is the duty of all Licensing Authorities to carry out their functions under the Act with a view to promoting the licensing objectives. The licensing objectives are:
 - a) The Prevention of Crime and Disorder
 - b) Public Safety
 - c) The Prevention of Public Nuisance
 - d) The Protection of Children from Harm.

Each objective is of equal importance. As there are no other licensing objectives, these four are of paramount consideration at all times. When considering applications, representations or notifications, the Licensing Authority will have regard to these licensing objectives.

- 5.4 The Licensing Authority may grant the application with or without additional conditions.
- 5.5 Section 4(3)Licensing Act 2003 states that the Licensing Authority should also have regard to the Council's Licensing Policy, the Statutory Guidance issued under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003, and the Licensing Act itself, and in particular to:
 - a) Paragraphs 3, 5, 6, 9, 10, 16, 17, 18, 20, 23, 24, 33 37, 41 to 44 of the 2011 policy.
 - b) Chapters 2, 8, 9 & 10 of the Statutory Guidance revised October 2014
 - c) Sections 4, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 16, 17, 18, 23, 182, and 183 of the Act.
- 5.6 The Licensing Authority recognises that Licensing and Planning are separate regimes. Where an application is granted by the Licensing Authority which would require planning permission this would not relieve the applicant of the need to obtain that permission. It will still be necessary for the applicant to ensure that he/she has **ALL** the necessary permissions in place to enable them to run the business within the law.
- 5.7 If the application is refused the applicant may appeal within 21 days of the notification to the Magistrates' Court. If the application is granted the person making the relevant representation may appeal within 21 days of the notification to the Magistrates' Court. On appeal the court may either dismiss the appeal, substitute the decision appealed against for any other decision which could have been made by the Licensing Authority, or remit the case to the Licensing Authority to dispose of in accordance with the direction of the court. The court may make such order for costs as it thinks fit.
- 5.8 In accordance with the requirements of the Act the copies of the application were sent to the police, the fire authority, environmental health, development control, trading standards, health authority and the child protection agency.
- 5.9 The applicant is required to place a notice at the premises for a period of 28 consecutive days starting the day after the application is made, and to place an advert in a local newspaper within 10 working days of submitting the application to the licensing authority.
- 5.10 A representation has been received from Avon & Somerset Constabulary (Annex B) in relation to the applicant's proposals and the police have the view that premises of this size within this already stressed area potentially allows for vertical drinking does nothing to further the licensing objectives in a cumulative impact area. To promote the licensing objectives, the following condition have been proposed by Avon & Somerset Constabulary and agreed in writing by the applicant (Annex C): 'Save for the bar area the supply and consumption of alcohol to be by waiter/waitress service to persons seated at the tables'.

There is no representation to the change in hours proposed.

- 5.11 The application proposes the consumption of alcohol "on premises" and falls within the cumulative impact area. As a representation has been received, there is a rebuttable presumption that the application will be refused unless the applicant has demonstrated that the application promotes the licensing objectives and would be unlikely to add significantly to the cumulative impact.
- 5.12 This report has not been sent to the Trades Union because they would have no involvement.

6. RATIONALE

6.1 As a representation has been received the Licensing Sub Committee must determine the application in accordance with the Licensing Act 2003.

7 OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED

7.1 None

8 CONSULTATION

- 8.1 In accordance with the Licensing Act 2003 (Premises Licence and Club Premises Certificate) Regulations 2005, the applicant has given notice of the application to all the relevant Responsible Authorities and has advertised the application in the manner prescribed, both at the premises and within a local publication.
- 8.2 Issues relating to Safeguarding have been considered in respect of this application.

9 RISK MANAGEMENT

9.1 A risk assessment related to the issue and recommendations has been undertaken, in compliance with the Council's decision making risk management guidance.

10 ADVICE SOUGHT

To remove the following condition:

"the supply and consumption of alcohol to be by waiter/waitress service to persons seated at tables"

To be replaced with:

"save for the bar area the supply and consumption of alcohol to be by waiter/waitress service to persons seated at tables"
