<b>Decision maker/s</b>	Cllr Anthony Clarke, Cabinet Member for Transport
<b>The Issue</b>	Whether the Council should continue and seal Order PEV11187/AC '(Various Roads, North West Outer Area, Bath (Prohibition and Restriction of Parking and loading) (No Stopping on Entrance Markings) (Authorised and Designated Parking Places) (Variation No. 1) Order 201- ' in association with the development adjacent to 1 Lark Place, Bath.
<b>Decision Date</b>	19 <sup>th</sup> November 2015
<b>The decision</b>	The Cabinet Member agrees that we should continue and seal Order PEV11187/AC '(Various Roads, North West Outer Area, Bath (Prohibition and Restriction of Parking and loading) (No Stopping on Entrance Markings) (Authorised and Designated Parking Places) (Variation No. 1) Order 201- ' as advertised.
