THE SALTFORD AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT ORDER 2013

The Bath and North East Somerset Council is satisfied that as a result of its air quality review and assessment, dated January 2011, the levels of nitrogen dioxide (NO2 annual mean) exceed the air quality objective level contained in the Air Quality (England) Regulations 2000 ("the Regulations") in the area described below.

The Bath and North East Somerset Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995 hereby makes the following order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Saltford Air Quality Management Area Order 2013.
- 2. The Air Quality Management Area will be an air quality management area in relation to nitrogen dioxide only.
- 3. The area is described as an area which covers the Bath Road, Saltford, encompassing any buildings whose facades are within the area. The area extends along the Bath Road from its junction with Beech Road until 150 metres south of the Glen. The detailed area is shown edged red on the attached plan.
- 4. The order will come into operation on the 4th July 2013.


