

STATEMENT BY MR A B HOOPER to the meeting on Thursday, 19th July 2008, at 10 a.m at the Guildhall, Bath, of the B&NES Council Trust Board of Bath Residents' Recreation Ground Charity No.1094519

Due to a total lack of prior consultation or earlier publication of the reports referred to in items 1 to 5 of today's agenda, it is impossible for beneficiaries to be familiar with, to have sought advice or in any way be properly prepared to adequately respond to any of these items especially within the unreasonable time constraint of three minutes only for all issues involved.

As Trustees you have repeatedly been warned that no further breaches of trust in contempt of the High Court and proper use of the Rec will be tolerated.


The Rec must be immediately returned to its proper purpose of clean, green and safe public Open Space, free of all selective domination and commercial exploitation for private gain.

All traffic and parking must be confined within the law and an adequate duty of care to the South Car Parks adjacent to the Sports Centre only.

If you, or the Charity Commission grant any further unlawful leases to Bath Rugby Plc beyond May 2008, then as you are already on notice you and the Plc will do so at your peril of legal action at any time from now onwards.

As a part owner and beneficiary I object to being excluded from any discussions as noted in agenda item 4, and would point out that devious secrecy has been the hallmark of the Council and the Charity Commission's conduct so far. This has deprived the Charity of enormous sums of money, and denied the beneficiaries of the very benefits and environmental amenity for which the Charity is so expressly intended, and subsequently affirmed by the Highest Court in the land to which you appear to continue in defiant contempt and for which you must sooner rather than later now be made to account for your deplorable conduct which shames the Council and spoils our City.
