

**Draft Public Realm & Movement Strategy for Bath City Centre

Further statistical analysis will be undertaken in light of the objections to the Bath

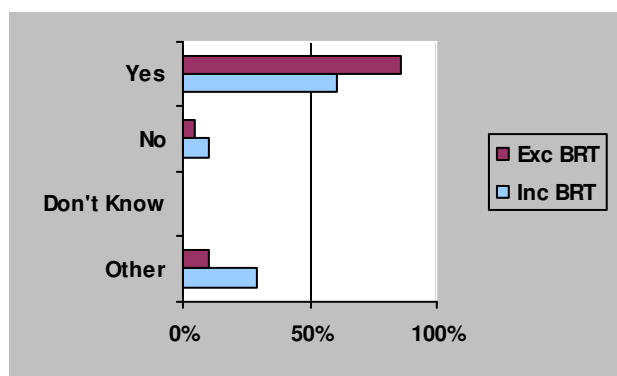
The statutory public consultation on the Draft Public Realm & Movement Strategy for Bath City Centre SPD ran from 8th January to 20th February 2009. In total 149 responses were received:

- 44 online
- 34 returned questionnaire
- 71 freehand written responses

Included within the 44 online responses, 28 responses did not answer the consultation questions but objected solely to the BRT project. Consequently, the analysis presented below presents the responses to the individual questions within the questionnaire, including and excluding the 28 BRT objections.

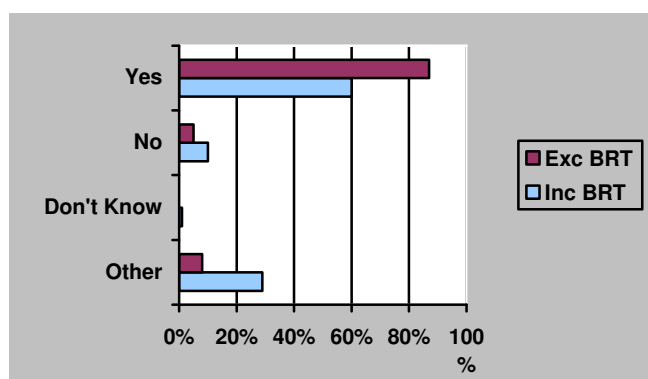
1. Do you agree with the case for transforming the public realm in Bath city centre?

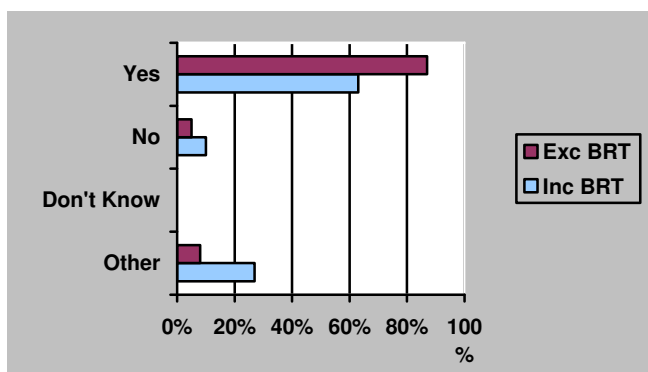
2. Do you agree with the overarching vision to invest in the public realm as the canvas for public life in Bath?

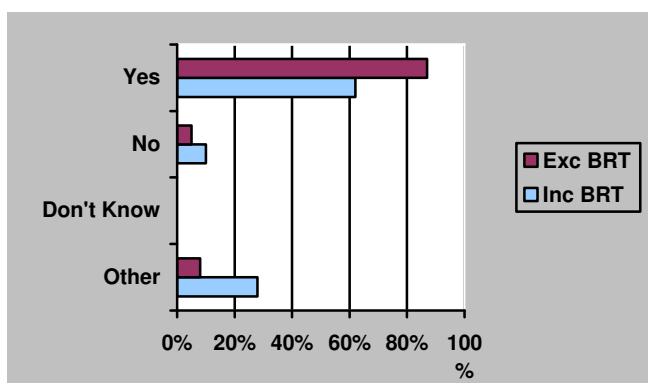
3. Do you support the concept of an integrated, long-term public realm framework to guide the transformation of Bath's movement systems and its streets, public spaces and riverside?

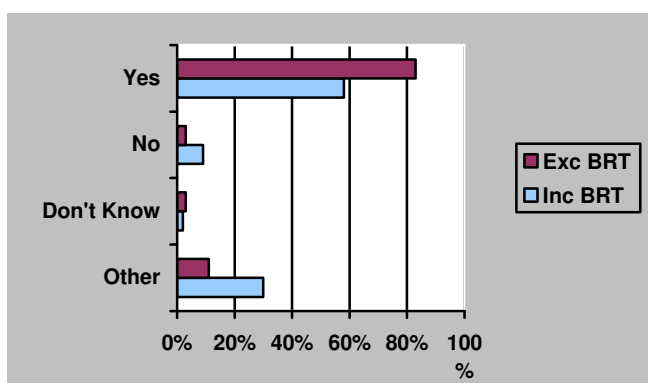
4. Do you agree with the overall recommendation to rebalance Bath city centre's movement systems in favour of the pedestrian, cyclist and public transport user?

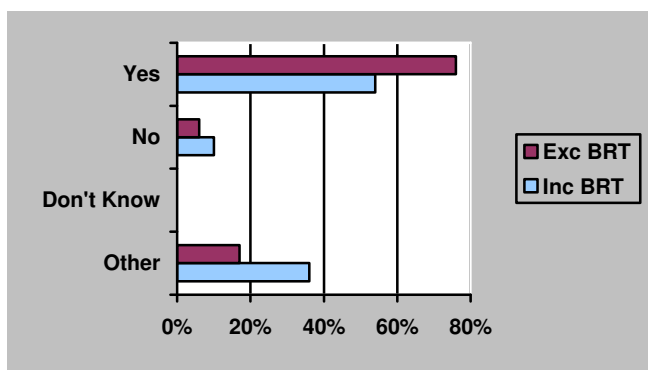
5. Do you agree with the overall recommendation to enhance and refashion the streets, public spaces and riverside within the city centre?

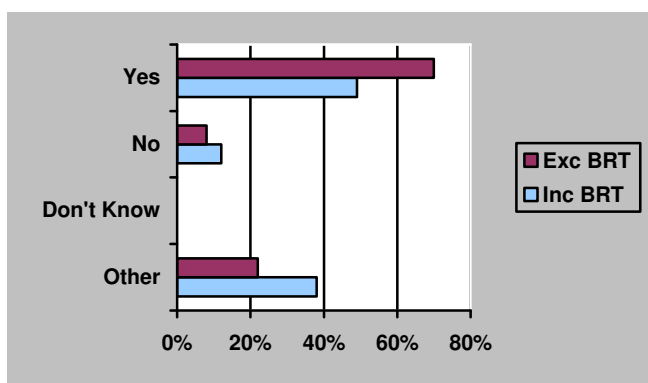
6. Do you agree with the overall recommendation to introduce a new information and wayfinding system to improve and increase pedestrian and public transport movement across the city centre?

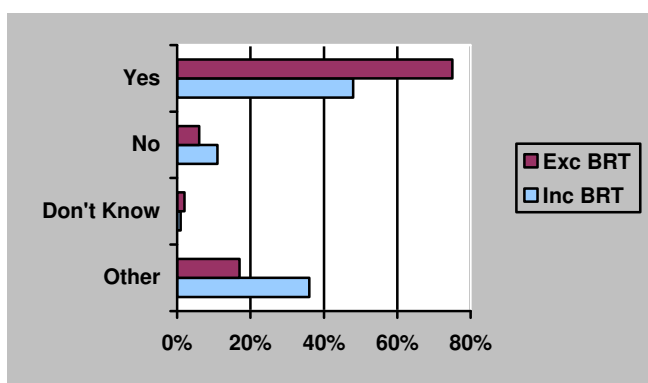

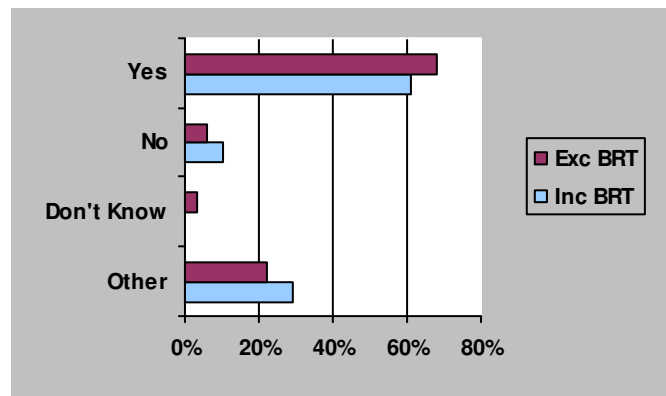
8. Do you agree with the proposed introduction of a Bath Pattern Book to set future design standards for public realm furniture for the city?
