The Issue	The B&NES plan sets out how all partners will work together to protect vulnerable people, prevent crime and build strong, resilient communities. It focuses on collective priorities with a shared vision, and actions that we, collectively, will take to achieve the best outcomes for individuals, families and communities. It sets out the PCC and council community safety objectives and planned activities for the next three years, identifying the key issues upon which we will focus to tackle crime, disorder and anti-social behaviour in Bath & North East Somerset.
