Culverhay: Next Steps

Date of Meeting	14-Jul-11
The Issue	To assess options for the future of Culverhay School
The decision	(1) To AGREE that its preferred option for Culverhay School would be for the school to become co-educational, either as an Academy or as a Free School;(2) To INSTRUCT officers to work with the school's Governing Body to deliver the preferred option at the earliest opportunity.
Rationale for decision	 The decision is the best way to deliver the Council's main priorities for Culverhay School: To ensure excellent educational provision for all children in the area; To allow girls to attend the school; To address the deficit which the school acknowledges will be a challenge; To encourage the school to collaborate with other schools to enhance educational standards.
Other options considered	There is no realistic option for the school to remain single-sex. Since the school has already applied for Academy status, there is no realistic option for the school to remain in the LEA.
