E2097 Review of Secondary Schools in Bath

Reconsidered Decision made 18-Aug-10 (Published on Council website 19-Aug-10)

A valid Call-in request was received. The Call-in was considered by the Children and Young People Overview and Scrutiny Panel on Tue 10-Aug-10 in the Guildhall, Bath. The Panel upheld the Call-in and referred the matter to Cabinet for them to reconsider the decision. The Cabinet considered this at a Special Cabinet meeting on Wed 18-Aug and decided to CONFIRM the original decision. This reconsidered decision is NOT subject to Call-in
