

EXECUTIVE FORWARD PLAN APRIL 2012

This Forward Plan seeks to anticipate all the Cabinet decisions to be made by the Cabinet, or by individual Cabinet members (and occasionally key decisions by officers) over the next four months.

The Forward Plan is updated regularly and re-issued on a monthly basis. It goes beyond the minimum legal requirement for only key decisions to be published over the coming four month period, and demonstrates the Council's commitment to openness and participation in decision making. It will also assist the Council's Overview & Scrutiny Panels in planning their input to policy formulation and development, and in reviewing the work of the Cabinet.
