As part of Homes England's Accelerated Construction housing programme the Council have been provisionally awarded grant funding in respect of the redevelopment of Bath Quays North (presently the Avon Street car and coach park), to assist with delivery of 92 new homes; and in respect of land at Englishcombe Lane, to assist with the delivery of 37 new homes. The funding is awarded to help unlock the development sites and increase the speed of housing delivery through investment in infrastructure provision and enabling works.

CALLED IN DECISIONS

These decisions were the subject of a call-in by 9 members. If the call-in is validated under the rules within the Constitution, the implementation of the decision cannot proceed. The decision will be examined through the overview and scrutiny process and a recommendation may be made back to the decision maker. If so, the response of the decision maker (the Cabinet member or the Cabinet, whichever is relevant) will be recorded in a subsequent Weekly List. Once made, this decision will not be eligible for a further call-in.
