#### **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

**Review Title: Affordable Housing Strategy Review** 

## **Review Purpose**

The purpose of this review is to provide input, via public consultation, to Bath & North East Somerset's draft `Affordable Housing Strategy'.

The review is being undertaken by Bath & North East Somerset Council's **Housing & Community Safety Overview & Scrutiny Panel** prior to the Affordable Housing Strategy being presented to the Executive in February 2004. The Panel's findings and recommendations will be made available to the Housing & Supported Living Service for them to incorporate in the final version of the Strategy before it is presented to the Executive.

The O&S Toolkit lists 9 different types of work. This review is work type A: Assisting the Council and Council Executive in the development of new policy. Type A is categorised as 'overview' rather than 'scrutiny'.

#### **Objectives**

The objectives of the review are to:

- Understand the issues of affordable housing in Bath & North East Somerset.
- Examine the Strategy's recommendations and plans to address the issues.
- Undertake consultation to seek the views of relevant stakeholders.
- Provide the Panels' recommendations to inform the development of the Strategy before it is presented to the Council Executive.

# Scope

To achieve its objectives, the Panel will:

- Seek the views of a wide range of consultees (to be agreed by the Chair with input from the Panel and the Housing & Supported Living Service).
- Hold an open public meeting to consider the recommendations and action plans arising from the Strategy, review consultation results and define the Panel's findings and recommendations on the issue.

#### **Outputs of this Review**

Consultation results.

- Notes & papers from a public meeting of the Housing & Community Safety O&S Panel (15<sup>th</sup> January 2004).
- The Panels recommendations and findings will be used to inform the development of the final draft Strategy by the Housing & Supported Living Service, before it is presented to the Executive.

## **Constraints**

- The final draft Strategy is due to be considered by the Executive at its 4<sup>th</sup>
  February meeting. The overview & scrutiny panel must therefore submit its
  findings and recommendations by 20<sup>th</sup> January so that the Housing &
  Supported Living Service may incorporate them in the final draft. An existing
  scheduled public meeting of the Panel (15<sup>th</sup> January) has been assigned to
  conclude this review. Summary comments will be prepared at that meeting for
  immediate referral.
- The review must be managed within the budget available to the Panel.
- The review will be carried out in accordance with the Bath & North East Somerset Council Overview and Scrutiny project management processes.
- The detailed knowledge of the Housing & Supported Living Services is essential in supporting this review. Service contacts are listed in the Project Team (below).
- Project Management resource is available from the Corporate Performance Unit (2 days per week).

#### **Risks**

- The review is being undertaken over a short time frame, which includes the Christmas & New Year holiday periods. Key members of the project team are on holiday during this period.
- The short timescale poses a risk to the quality of the review and may limit the ability to undertake consultation and for consultees to respond.
- The review will require significant participation from Councillors on the Panel who may already have other commitments on their time.
