- ① I cannot see what significant contribution this one tree makes to the area, there are no other trees nearby, the tree is on the back of my garden next to railway bank, which is also at the end of my private road
- ② The tree is dangerously big with big heavy branches which do fall off constantly, worse in wet + windy weather,
- ③ It has done damage to a neighbouring garage roof as shown in pics.
- ④ I have had tree surgeons around more than one company say it is a Chestnut tree not Sycamore??
- ⑤ My concern is that my grandchildren use this land to play and the branches keep falling down will hurt them.
- ⑥ There was trees along the railway bank, this tree was planted wrong on my side of the boundary, The railway have removed the trees from the railway bank and would have removed the one on my ground if it was the other side of boundary.
