The decision	The Cabinet member agrees that, subject to scheme delivery proposals being approved through the PID process:  1.1 The scheme is approved as advertised,  1.2 That the objectors are informed accordingly.
Rationale for decision	The introduction of a 20mph speed limit will improve the environment, and it should encourage more walking and cycling.
Financial and budget implications	Funding for the scheme is available from Council Capital.
Issues considered	Social Inclusion; Customer Focus; Sustainability; Human Resources; Property; Young People; Human Rights; Corporate; Health & Safety.
Consultation undertaken	Ward Councillor; Cabinet colleagues; Staff; Other B&NES Services; Service Users; Local Residents; Section 151 Finance Officer; Chief Executive; Monitoring Officer.
How consultation was carried out	This was carried out by letter drop with a comment feedback freepost return, formal consultation by public advertisement of the proposals for 21 days and publication of the Single Member Decision Report.
Other options considered	An alternative option to introduce 20mph speed limit zones would have required the introduction of traffic calming measures but was considered to be too expensive.
