1. The Trustees support a tenant (Bath Rugby plc) occupying only part of the Recreation Ground actively seeking out local defendants to pursue in a High Court action seeking a declaration re the 1932 covenant?

2. That the Trustees are aware that it is the responsibility of the freeholder, ie the Trust, who should seek any declaration or modification, not the tenant?

3. That the Trustees whilst supporting Bath Rugby in its High Court action are in parallel objecting to a Village Green application despite the Rec being used informally and formally for over 100 years by local residents for participative games and sports of all kinds, that a right of way is established at the Land Registry and that local residents have always had rights of way over the land to access their property and the River?
