Existing Rural Primary Schools Admission Criteria

PRIORITY A

Children in Public care [Looked after Children]. Or a child who was previously looked after but immediately after being looked after became subject to an adoption, residence, or special guardianship order.

PRIORITY B

Children for whom there will be a sibling in attendance on the admission date at the preferred school and for whom this is the closest community or voluntary controlled school as measured in a direct line.

PRIORITY C

Children for whom the school is the closest community or voluntary controlled school as measured in a direct line.

PRIORITY D

Children for whom there are siblings already in attendance at the preferred school who will be in attendance on the admission date and who live closer to another school as measured in a direct line.

PRIORITY E

Children who live closer to another school as measured in a direct line.
