<b>The Issue</b>	To consider letters of objection received by email to the construction of a Zebra Crossing and the variation of waiting restrictions, limited parking and residents' parking places on Bathwick Hill, Bathwick.
<b>Decision Date</b>	29 April 2013
<b>The decision</b>	The Cabinet Member has decided not to implement the crossing proposal
<b>Rationale for decision</b>	The Cabinet Member took into consideration all the comments received during the two consultation periods and decided that the proposals should not be implemented

<b>Issues considered</b>	Social Inclusion; Customer Focus; Sustainability
<b>Consultation undertaken</b>	Ward Councillor; Cabinet colleagues; Staff; Other B&NES Services; Local Residents; Section 151 Finance Officer; Monitoring Officer
<b>How consultation was carried out</b>	Consultation was initially carried out with Ward Councillors, the Police, the Emergency Services, Freight Transport Association, RAC Motoring Services, Road Haulage Association and local residents. Later consultation was carried out through an advertisement in the local press and on street.
<b>Other options considered</b>	A staggered crossing arrangement and a crossing located closer to the roundabout junction with Pulteney Road
