The Issue	To consider the points raised during the public advertisement to introduce a permanent area-wide 20mph speed limit on the residential roads of Keynsham.
Decision Date	10 05 2013
The decision	The Cabinet Member agrees that, subject to scheme delivery proposals being approved through the PID process that the speed limit order is approved as advertised, but with the exception of Park Close which is a private access road.
Rationale for decision	The introduction of a 20mph speed limit will improve the environment, and it should encourage more walking and cycling.
Financial and budget implications	Funding for the scheme is available from Council Capital.

Other options considered	An alternative option to introduce a 20mph speed limit zone would have required the introduction of traffic calming measures, but this was considered to be too expensive.
