<b>The Issue</b>	The report set out the priority areas where play equipment is proposed to be replaced as part of the 2013/14 capital programme, including arrangements for local consultation as appropriate
<b>Decision Date</b>	23 Dec 2013
<b>The decision</b>	The Cabinet Members agree that the proposed funding allocations for 2013/14 be approved
<b>Rationale for decision</b>	The available funding must be directed towards replacing the equipment that is considered to be at the end of its life in order to limit liability for the Council and to ensure the continuation of existing service levels
<b>Financial and budget implications</b>	The capital sum of £225,000 is approved within the Council's 2013/14 budget and provision to repay this through service supported borrowing is incorporated within the relevant Service revenue budget. Provision to fund the on-going inspection and maintenance of replacement play equipment is incorporated within the relevant Service revenue budget
<b>Issues considered</b>	Social Inclusion; Customer Focus; Sustainability; Young People; Equality (age, race, disability, religion/belief, gender, sexual orientation); Corporate; Health & Safety
<b>Consultation undertaken</b>	Cabinet colleagues; Staff; Other B&NES Services; Section 151 Finance Officer; Monitoring Officer
<b>How consultation was carried out</b>	Through meetings and email correspondence
<b>Other options considered</b>	None
