The abuse of Trust property is caused by the very presence of the Rugby Club, a professional enterprise operated for commercial gain, on land that was left in trust for the purposes set out in the objects of the Recreation Ground Charity.

The abuse can only be rectified by developing a scheme whereby the detriment to the beneficiaries caused by the loss of trust assets is balanced by benefits accruing from replacement or return of assets of equal utility in the pursuit of the objectives of the trust.
