PARISHES LIAISON MEETING – 18TH JUNE 2014

BRIEFING NOTE FROM JOHN WILKINSON ON RURAL BROADBAND (taken under Item 4 – urgent business)

- 1. BT have begun survey work through the BDUK programme in the B&NES area as expected and have been in conversation with the highways department about delivering the first cabinets.
- 2. The Connecting Devon and Somerset board is conserving the offer from BDUK for the extension programme and how best to deploy funding in the area.
- 3. B&NES Council has facilitated a meeting between Wansdyke Telecom CiC and Connecting Devon and Somerset as early engagement in the extension programme, which was positive.
- 4. Wansdyke Telecom CiC have also been in to speak to the B&NES planning department about the deployment of their own programme
- 5. B&NES council have held a number of positive meetings with parishes to explore their options where they are within the current commercial rollout, but speeds remain low.
- 6. B&NES Council continues to explore opportunities to find other means outside these programmes to support access to faster broadband schemes, including at the Local Enterprise Partnership.
