The decision	The Cabinet Members agree that the acquisition of the property by way of assignment takes place.
	The decision is being taken under the special Urgency provisions of the Council's constitution under Rule 4 – Urgent Executive Decisions in accordance with the provision of Access to Information Rule 16. The Chair of the Resources PDS Panel has agreed that special urgency provisions apply. The comments of the Chief Executive, Monitoring Officer and Chief Financial Officer were also obtained.
Rationale for decision	The rationale for the decision is based on the business plan.
Financial and budget implications	The intention is to temporarily finance the requirements of the acquisition by way of the generation of capital receipts from further disposals and/or restructuring of individual leases within the Commercial Estate. The method of temporary financing will be a Treasury Management decision and will be based on the availability of cash balances, the overriding need to borrow and any other considerations required to manage the Council's cash and debt positions.
