

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL

(LANSDOWN ROAD, BATH) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF PARKING)
ORDER 201-

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, makes the following order: -

1. This order comes into operation on the ** **** 201* and may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Lansdown Road, Bath) (Prohibition and Restriction of Parking) Order 201-.
2. In this order, :-
 - “delivering” and “collecting” in relation to goods includes checking those goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;
 - "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 (“the 2000 Regulations”);
 - “electronic communications apparatus” has the same meaning as in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - “goods” means any article not easily carried by hand and includes postal packets;
 - “parking” or to “be parked” means leaving a vehicle or permitting it to remain at rest, whether the vehicle is attended or unattended and includes “waiting” and to “wait”;
 - "parking disc" has the same meaning as in the 2000 Regulations;
 - “postal packets” and “universal service provider” has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2011; and
 - "relevant position" has the same meaning as in the 2000 Regulations.

Prohibition and Restriction of Parking

3. (1) Subject to Articles 4 and 5 a vehicle must not be parked in any length of road specified in Schedule 1.
- (2) Subject to Articles 4 and 5 a vehicle must not be parked in any length of road specified in Schedule 2 Monday to Saturday between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.

Exemptions

4. Article 3 does not apply to a vehicle that is parked for as long as is necessary:-
 - (a) to enable a person to get in or out of the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in another road, to be used in connection with:-
 - (i) scaffolding or demolition operations;
 - (ii) removing an obstruction or emptying gullies;
 - (iii) maintaining, improving or reconstructing any road; or
 - (iv) laying, erecting, altering or repairing any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or electronic communications apparatus;

- (c) to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority, the Environment Agency, a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (d) to enable the vehicle, if it is a universal service provider, to be used to deliver or collect, load or unload postal packets;
- (e) for the vehicle to stop if required to do so by law, to avoid an accident, or if it is unavoidable for any other reason;
- (f) to enable the vehicle to be used at or near premises adjacent to that road in connection with:
 - (i) a wedding or funeral; or
 - (ii) the cleaning of windows whilst using equipment attached to and working from the vehicle; or
- (g) to deliver or collect, load or unload the following from premises adjacent to the road, if the premises do not include an adequate off-street loading area and if those activities cannot conveniently be done in another road:
 - (i) goods; or
 - (ii) cash or other valuables or valuable securities which cannot reasonably be carried by hand.

5. Article 3 does not apply to the following:-

- (a) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (b) a vehicle when it is being directed by a police constable in uniform; or
- (c) a vehicle lawfully displaying in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge which is exempt for a period of three hours subject to the conditions that:
 - (i) the period of exempted parking does not begin less than one hour after a previous period of exempted parking by the same vehicle in the same road on the same day; and
 - (ii) a parking disc is displayed in the relevant position on the vehicle marked to show the quarter hour period during which the period of exempted parking began.
