**Outer Area Bath Residents & Controlled Parking Zone 16 Order**

<b>Decision maker/s</b>	Cllr Charles Gerrish, Cabinet Member for Service Delivery
<b>The Issue</b>	To consider the comments raised during the public advertisement for the Traffic Regulation Order, advertised from the 12th August for a period of 21 days, to introduce the Zone 16 residents parking area. These comments are included within the appendix attached to this report.
<b>Decision Date</b>	7 <sup>th</sup> December 2010
<b>The decision</b>	The Cabinet Member agrees that The objections be over ruled and the scheme proceed as advertised. The contacts who made comments shown in the appendix be notified of the decision That a usage survey be undertaken of the parking bays in Cleveland Place during the spring 2011
<b>Rationale for decision</b>	The current parking problems in this area are a daily source of annoyance for local residents. It is considered that the introduction of residents parking will enable the proper control of on-street parking. This would include Walcot Parade and Anglo Terrace but there are a number of objections to (and support for) this.
<b>Financial and budget implications</b>	All costs incurred in relation to implementing this scheme will be met from this financial year's budget
<b>Issues considered</b>	Customer Focus; Other Legal Considerations
<b>Consultation undertaken</b>	Ward Councillors; Service Users; Local Residents/Stakeholders/Partners; Section 151 Finance Office.
<b>How consultation was carried out</b>	The proposals were advertised on site and in the Public Notices section of the Bath Chronicle from 12 <sup>th</sup> August to 3 <sup>rd</sup> September 2010.
<b>Other options considered</b>	An alternative scheme was advertised on 26 <sup>th</sup> November 2009 which did not include Walcot Parade or Anglo Terrace.
