**Objections received to the implementation of a bus lane
and associated Traffic Regulation Orders in Wellsway, Bath**

The Issue	To consider objections received to the implementation of vehicle turning bans and motor vehicle restrictions at the junction of Wellsway and Hatfield Road (East) Bath
Decision Date	08 December 2010.
The decision	<p>The Cabinet Member agrees that The movement and turning bans at the junction of Wellsway and Hatfield Road (East) should be implemented as proposed.</p> <p>The Hatfield Road (East) contra flow cycle lane eastbound should be implemented as proposed.</p> <p>A separate report should be brought forward at a later date for the lead Member to consider other objections received to the proposed bus lane, waiting and movement restrictions on Wellsway and Hatfield Road (West).</p>
Rationale for decision	The proposal to introduce vehicle turning bans and a no motor vehicles order on Hatfield Road (East), is to improve road safety, congestion and pollution for all who use or live near Wellsway.
Financial and budget implications	A budget to implement this scheme has been included in the 2010/2011 capital budget (Greater Bristol Bus Network (GBBN) grant).

How consultation was carried out	<p>Informal consultation with residents of the Wellsway and Greenway Lane has been on going since May 2003.</p> <p>The formal consultation was carried out in 2010 by e-mail to the statutory consultees providing details of the proposals with a plan and statement of reasons attached. The proposals were also advertised in accordance with legal requirements, in the press and on street for a period of six weeks, and were also available for Public inspection at the Council Offices</p>
