The AMR is a component of the Local Development Framework (LDF) and it performs two key tasks:  (i) The review of plan production progress i.e. an assessment of the implementation of the Local Development Scheme (LDS) and;  (ii) The monitoring of plan output to assess the extent to which Development Plan policies are being implemented and the degree to which the objectives of the Local Development Framework are being met.
