**St Stephen's Safety Scheme, Objections received to
proposed waiting restrictions and speed table**

Decision maker/s	Cllr Charles Gerrish, Cabinet Member for Customer Services
The Issue	To consider objections received to advertised Traffic Regulation Orders , and consideration of an alternative scheme.
Decision Date	22 12 2010
The decision	The Cabinet Member agrees that The revised scheme without the speed table and footpath at Beacon Road / Richmond Place should be progressed. The reduced waiting restrictions as proposed should be implemented. The existing footpath between Beacon Road and Summerfield Road.
Rationale for decision	The advertised waiting restrictions in the area of Beacon Road and Richmond Place were part of safer routes to school scheme, but the effect on residents was considered to be excessive and an alternative scheme involving the upgrading of an existing footway was proposed.
Financial and budget implications	Finance to implement the revised scheme is included in the 2010/11 budget.

Consultation undertaken	Ward Councillor; Overview & Scrutiny Panel; Other B&NES Services; Service Users; Local Residents; Community Interest Groups; Other Public Sector Bodies; Section 151 Finance Officer; Chief Executive; Monitoring Officer
How consultation was carried out	Consultation began with local meetings with interested parties and was advertised in the press and on site, residents also received information through a letter drop.
