Summary	Your care, your way is a bold and ambitious review of community health and care services for children, young people and adults being carried out jointly by NHS Bath and North East Somerset Clinical Commissioning Group and Bath & North East Somerset Council. Over the past ten months we have been listening to the views of local people and organisations delivering services. We have been working together to review and develop proposals to improve the delivery of integrated community health and care services to the people and communities of Bath and North East Somerset. The Outline Business Case approved by Governing Bodies in December 2016 describes proposals for achieving a local model of integrated health and care that improves outcomes and system sustainability both now and in the future. We have undertaken an extensive engagement programme in order to inform future commissioning intentions set out in the Outline Business Case approved by governing bodies in December 2015. The your care, your way consultation has reached over 2,000 individuals during this phase and we gathered feedback from service users, patients, carers and members of the public who may be service users in the future as well as from those people delivering and commissioning services. Phase Two of the review which began in May 2015 and concluded with a seven week formal consultation period from 10 September to 30 October 2015.
