The Issue	Replace the existing pre application advice charging regime with a new schedule, alongside significant improvements to the quality and timeliness of the pre application advice service

The decision	The Cabinet Member agrees that Development Management Service can implement a revised pre application advice charging schedule
Rationale for decision	 These are changes to an existing service which is already well used The price increase is alongside extensive improvements to the quality and timeliness of the service customers will receive Our main customer group, the Agents have be advised and what feedback we have received has been supportive In the current climate, increase in income is appropriate and enables costs of delivering the pre app service to be covered We do not expect a significant reduction in the number of pre-apps we receive as a result of these changes as all indications are that customers expect us to deliver this service
