



St Keyna Primary School – Basic Need Expansion

Decision maker/s	Cllr Michael Evans, Cabinet Member for People & Communities
The Issue	Pupil Numbers in the Keynsham/Saltford area are increasing and additional accommodation is required at St Keyna Primary School to provide more places.
Decision Date	20 May 2016
The decision	The Cabinet Member agrees to approve a capital budget of £436,974 from the 2016/17 Basic Need Capital programme to provide additional accommodation and carry out minor remodelling works at St Keyna Primary School.
Rationale for decision	To meet the Council's legal responsibility for pupil place planning in its area.
Financial and budget implications	Provisional approval of £2.605m unallocated Basic Need Grant Funding was agreed in the Council's 2016/17 Budget Report for emerging basic need schemes. The Keynsham area was identified as a potential call on this funding. There are no revenue implications

How consultation was carried out	<p>All schools and Heads in the local area were consulted and asked to consider taking additional pupils to meet increased need in September 2016. St Keyna consulted their governing body and agreed to the proposals. Discussions have been ongoing with the Head, Governing Body and staff.</p> <p>The adjoining nursery school has been appraised of the plans and a drop in event was held on 4th May 2016 to discuss the project with local residents and Members.</p>
Other options considered	Expansion at other schools in the local area. Transportation of pupils to schools outside of the local area where places are available.
