The Issue	There have been no recent increases in the charges made by the Registration Service for Ceremonies, most notably for those held in The Guildhall, Bath, and consequently they have now become significantly out of step with the market and contain some internal inconsistencies. This has been highlighted by a service review and changes to prices		
	are now recommended.

The decision	The Cabinet Member agrees to increase the charges for ceremonies undertaken by the Registration Service (with the exception of those ceremonies with a statutory set fee), with effect from 1st October 2016, to increase the Approved Premises Licence fees in line with increased costs, with effect from 1st October 2016 and to honour all existing bookings until 31st March 2017 at the current rates.		
Rationale for decision	The increased charges are needed to support the increasing cost to deliver the ceremonies in The Guildhall. The increase in Approved Premises licence fee reflects the cost to deliver this licensing activity.		
Financial and budget implications	The increased charges will help the Registration service fully recover its costs in delivering its service and to catch up with inflation as the fees have not been reviewed since 2013. There is an increasing demand from customers to make their wedding/civil partnerships individual and bespoke events. For all ceremonies, it is proposed that the time will be extended from 30 minutes to 1 hour to allow and encourage greater personalisation of ceremonies by customers. There are some increased staffing costs to achieve this service improvement that are covered by these increases.
