CHARITY COMMISSION

THE CHARITY COMMISSIONERS FOR ENGLAND AND WALES HEREBY ORDER that the following Scheme be approved and established.

SCHEME

- 1. Subject to the provisions of this Scheme, the Trustees may grant to Bath and North East Somerset District Council, a lease of the land and building specified in the schedule hereto, for a term of 21 years at a yearly rent of £1.
- 2. The lease shall contain a provision for the preservation, repair and maintenance of such building by the lessee and all other usual and proper covenants applicable to the property comprised therein.
- 3. The land and building shall be appropriated and used by the lessee-should belessee for purposes not inconsistent with the object of the Charity, which purposes may include use as a museum of costume.

4. The Trustees must comply with the restrictions on disposal imposed by Section 36 of the Charities Act 1993, unless the disposal is excepted from these restrictions by Section 36 (9) (b) or (c) or Section 36 (10) of that Act.
