The decision	The Cabinet Member agrees that the £200,000 provision approval in the 2017/18 Budget be given full approval in order to resolve the TROs and improvement works.
Rationale for decision	Experimental Traffic Regulation Orders have been used to assess how the current on-road cycling facility and parking/ loading restrictions have performed under the Road Traffic Act 1984. These will expire 16th June 2017 and 11th November respectively, preventing continuing legal enforcement, which could lead to traffic violations. Resolution of these TRO's will be required through a Single Member Decision in advance of the above dates. The performance of the scheme and comments received during the period of the experimental Traffic Regulation Orders will be reviewed and where it is deemed beneficial improvement works will be implemented within the budget approval. Based on Rationale from the covering report}
Financial and budget implications	£200,000 has been provisionally approved in the 2017/18 Capital Budget which will be funded through Corporate Supported Borrowing. The works will improve existing assets and will be revenue neutral.
