

Draft Locally Listed Heritage Assets Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) Consultation Questionnaire

General Guidance

- 1.1 Bath & North East Somerset Council has prepared a draft Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) in relation to identification, recording and management of Locally Listed Heritage Assets within the Council's area. Once finalised, the SPD will enable better informed development management decisions regarding the conservation and enhancement of local character, as well as informing current and future Council strategies. The document also aims to raise the profile and encourage recognition of the contribution that non-designated heritage assets make to the special character of Bath and North East Somerset.
- 1.2 The following questionnaire has been devised to help the Local Planning Authority understand what local residents and others with an interest in the area and conservation of its heritage consider important in relation to non-designated heritage assets identification and management, especially in relation to development of the selection criteria and the nomination process. We would be grateful if you could take time to complete it.
- 1.3 Following the public consultation all contributions will be scrutinised and the SPD amended accordingly. It will then require formal approval and adoption by the Council for development management purposes.
- 1.4 Before completing this questionnaire, please have a look at the Draft Locally Listed Heritage Assets SPD and supporting documentation, all of which are available at the BANES website (www.bathnes.gov.uk) or in paper form at the Council's offices and libraries. In order to answer the questions, you will need to be in a position to refer to the SPD and its contents.
- 1.5 There is an opportunity to expand upon each question, and there's also a general comments box provided at the end of the questionnaire should you have any additional comments to make on the SPD that are not dealt with as part of the structured questioning. Please note that this consultation only concerns the Draft Locally Listed Heritage Assets SPD.. Information extrapolated from your questionnaire may be made public as part of the process leading to adoption.
