The Issue	The report outlines changes to parking allocations in line with the hierarchy of kerb space in the Parking Strategy and their financial implications.

The decision	The Cabinet Members agree to; <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Note the changes to parking as proposed in the report and in line with the hierarchy of kerb space.2. Support the implementation of the Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) to allow the changes to be implemented
Rationale for decision	The Parking Strategy clearly sets out the hierarchy of kerb space and the commitment to put residents first.
Financial and budget implications	Following the implementation of the Parking Strategy a net reduction in paid for parking spaces will impact on Parking Service's ability to achieve set budgets in the current and future financial years. If a reduction in income is identified this pressure should be incorporated into the financial planning assumptions for consideration when setting the 2019/20 budget.
