Homesearch Allocation Scheme Update

The Issue	The Homesearch Allocation Scheme details who is eligible for social housing and how we decide who should be housed first. The current scheme was approved May 2016 and we are now proposing a number of amendments and technical changes to bring it in line with recent statutory changes and to improve implementation in partnership with registered housing providers.
Decision Date	On or after 31st January 2019
The decision	The Cabinet Member agrees to adopt the amended allocation scheme, known as the Homesearch Allocation Scheme 2019.
Rationale for decision	These amendments will ensure that housing allocations continue to create balanced communities where people choose to live, make the best use of the housing stock, prioritise those in greatest need and adopt new flexibilities in line with changes to housing regulations.
