#### Mental Health Services delivered in B&NES

# Secondary Mental Health Care Services for adults commissioned by BSW and delivered by AWP

- a) **Early Intervention Team**; This service provides a multidisciplinary approach to help people in psychosis and provides support to them and their families as early as possible, giving them the best chance of preventing long term problems.
- b) **Primary Care Mental Health Liaison Service (PCLS)**; This service is the main integrated referral point into adult secondary mental health services and the team provides mental health support, brief interventions, advice and signposting for; service users and potential users of mental health services, their carers and relatives, GPs, Health and Social Care and third sector.
- c) **Primary Care Talking Therapies**; This service offers support to people with common emotional, communication and mental health difficulties such as anxiety, depression and stress. Services range from self-help therapies, to psychoeducational courses and one-to-one support.
- d) **Intensive Team**; This service provides assessment and home treatment for people aged over 16 years experiencing a mental health crisis, as an alternative to hospital admission. The team operates 24 hours a day 7 days a week.
- e) **Recovery Team**; This is the main service to provide ongoing care, treatment and support for service users, their families, friends and supporters. The service will provide specific periods of interventions to service users requiring short or long term support to assist their recovery.
- f) Complex Intervention and Treatment Team (CITT); This service is built around specialist teams that help meet the changing psychosocial and environmental needs of an ageing population and to promote successful ageing.
- g) Adult Acute Psychiatric Inpatient (Sycamore Ward) Provide multi-disciplinary, multi-skilled treatment to people whose health care needs cannot be managed in their own homes due to their level of complexity, intensity and unpredictability. Inpatient services are for people whose health needs require specialist investigation, assessment and intervention. B&NES residents will be admitted to an inpatient bed on Sycamore Ward at Hillview Lodge in Bath, wherever possible. However when clinically necessary and to ensure that treatment is provided without delay, they may be admitted to a bed in another appropriate AWP Trust site.
- h) Later Life Specialist Inpatient (Ward 4) Highly specialist assessment and treatment is provided to service users whose circumstances or needs mean that they cannot be treated and supported appropriately at home or in any other environment. Building work is currently underway on the AWP Hillview Lodge site to provide new high-quality accommodation in order to relocate Ward 4, the 12 bedded specialist

dementia unit currently located in St. Martins Hospital (4 miles away in Bath) - which had been the only remaining dormitory-style ward in AWP and was not suitable to be reconfigured to deliver Single Sex Accommodation regulatory standards.
