	Approve the redevelopment of 117 Newbridge Hill, Bath into apartments by ACL in line with the Business Case detailed in the report;

	 Agree that ACL may enter into an associated commercial loan agreement with the Council, as detailed in the report.
Rationale for decision	To provide six quality apartments in Bath targeted at professional workers and first-time buyers. Sustainability, energy efficiency and space standards will be improved.
	The decision will not be subject to call in by virtue of part 4 D (1) of the Council's Constitution, which specifically excludes from call in decisions of the Leader acting in their capacity as Shareholder of a Local Authority Company owned or operated by the Council.
