Price of Primary School Meals

Date of Meeting	13-Jul-11
The Issue	The Cabinet is asked to consider a proposal to set the price of primary school meals from 1 st September 2011
The decision	(1) To AGREE that the price of a school meal for a pupil in the Council's primary schools will not increase from 1 September 2011 and will stay at £2.00 per meal.
Rationale for decision	Although a price increase would help to offset increases in the cost of providing school meals, there is a continuing increase in the cost of living that affects all families in our communities and the Cabinet wishes to support families, particularly those on low incomes who wish to buy school meals
Other options considered	A range of options was considered, from no increase in price to an increase of 10 pence per meal
