	Local Resident	Tynning Road Combe Down	Object	I would like to register an objection to the TRO insofar as it relates to Tynning Road. It seems to be highly unsuitable restriction for this narrow and purely residential road. What alternative parking arrangements are to be made for residents What will be done about the twice a day Monkton Combe School run which swamps Tynning Road	Tynning Road near its junction with North Road is currently subject to no waiting at any time. These proposals add short sections on no waiting at any time to improve visibility and manoeuvrability at its junction with Gladstone Road and North Road. Should vehicles park on the existing no waiting at any time on Tynning Road, claiming an exemption they obstruct access for other vehicles. The proposed loading prohibition removes the exemptions to park and therefore improve access.
	Local Residents	The Avenue	Object	We understand that some of the double yellow lines are to be removed on The Avenue near The Firs. I agree with this but I object that some are to be limited waiting. They should be unrestricted to maximise long stay parking	The proposals will still allow large sections of unrestricted parking along the Avenue. The limited waiting will create additional and much needed short stay parking for visitors to the local surgery and businesses. The existing limited waiting does not meet the demands which could be detrimental to the economic viability for some of the businesses. The limited waiting can still be utilised by local residents for long stay parking at the end and beginning of the restriction and for overnight parking
