The decision	 The Council Leader agrees: A revision to the Business Case for 117 Newbridge Hill Bath to replace the proposed top floor two-bed apartment with 2 one-bed apartments. To approve the amendment of the related Development Agreement to reflect the above change in configuration. To approve the acquisition of the site at Malmains Drive, South Glos under a Sales and Overage Agreement for development in line with the approved planning application. To approve the development loan borrowing from South Glos Council on the commercial terms as set out in the Business Case to deliver this development.
Rationale for decision	The recommendations set out in this report are in line with the Aequus Business Plan and will enable the Council's development Company ACL to continue to develop and, deliver the objectives set for it by the Council (as Shareholder). The decision will enable the provision and delivery of new homes and support the delivery of the income targets set for the Company in the Council's approved Medium-Term Financial Plan.
