10 CONSULTATION

- 10.1 The Leader of the Council and CEO were consulted as part of the proposal to undergo a recruitment process to appoint two new non-executive directors. The roles were advertised on the Council and Aequus websites, social media, local partner organisations via a press release on 28th January 2022 and was also advertised in The Guardian (on-line). There was a particular emphasis on attracting a diverse range of candidates for the identified skillsets which included previous non-executive roles, property sales and marketing, private rental market, housing development and construction, local authority companies and company governance.
- 10.2 The role attracted 32 applications of a high standard. The applicants were shortlisted to 9 with the top 5 being invited for interview. The interview panel consisted of 2 representatives of the Shareholder, 2 Aequus Board of Directors and an Executive Director.
