The Issue	Approval of Strategic CIL (Community Infrastructure Levy) funding for Cleveland Pools Trust This is to request the approval of £250k grant funding for Cleveland Pools Trust, funded from Strategic CIL.
Decision Date	24 March 2022
The decision	The Cabinet Member agrees to fully approve £250k for Cleveland Pools Trust being funded by Strategic CIL.
Rationale for decision	The decision will enable the Council to allocate grant funding towards the completion of the project to restore and re-open the open-air public swimming baths.
