## School Term and Holiday Dates 2024-25 Academic Year

Decision maker/s	Cllr Dine Romero, Cabinet Member for Children and Young People, Communities
The Issue	To approve the school term and holiday dates for the 2024-25 academic year
Decision Date	21 <sup>st</sup> March 2023
The decision	The Cabinet Member agrees to approve the Council's preferred calendar of school term and holiday dates and to recommend these to all schools for the 2024-25 academic year.
Rationale for decision	Following consultation, local authorities are expected to approve a calendar of school term and holiday dates for schools within their area.
	Multi Academy Trusts (MATs), Academies, Foundation, Free Schools and Voluntary Aided Schools have the power to determine their own dates.
	The Council proposes a 195-day model for term dates with 5 in-service days being taken outside of these dates.
	The Council endeavours to set dates in line with neighbouring local authorities where this is possible.
	Following approval of the agreed school term and holiday dates these will be circulated to all schools and published on the Council's website
Financial and budget implications	Timing of the Easter holiday period may vary slightly from year to year but an increase in costs in one year will be compensated by a fall in costs the following year.
	If as a result of a school adopting their own dates, there is an increase in home to school transport costs the Council will recover the additional cost from the school
