	An allocation of £52,389 to Bath Youth for Christ for the refurbishment of the toilets and kitchen facilities at the Roundhill Hub.
	An allocation of £74,919 to Your Park Bristol & Bath to create the UK's first park to meet young females needs at Brickfields.
Rationale for decision	In the absence of a Parish Council for Bath, the Bath and North East Somerset Council has a statutory responsibility to allocate the local portion of CIL.
	To agree the recommendations from the CIL for Bath Advisory Board relating to the eleventh allocation of funding to one project from Bath's "neighbourhood portion" of the Community Infrastructure Levy.
Financial and budget implications	All projects are costed through the receipts that Bath Neighbourhood CiL that has already received.
	The applicants will complete a funding grant agreement which will be signed and returned before payment is made. Where projects are being funded through multiple payments. After the initial payment has been made, the applicant must return a monitoring report that covers the previous year's spend and outcomes. Only on completion will the

	next payment be made.
	Once the agreed payments are completed there will be no additional ongoing funding.
