The Issue	The implementation of a new SEND Home to School Travel Policy

The decision	The Cabinet Member agrees the implementation of the new SEND Home to School Travel policy.
Rationale for decision	The B&NES Home to School Transport Policy required updating due to new statutory guidance issued in January 2024. The policy had become outdated, causing confusion for parents and operational difficulties within the team. The Policy has been updated to meet this new guidance, and to allow for consistent decision making under the policy. This will allow the Council to better manage our resources.
